

## Discussion Questions on Coronavirus Video

1. Name 1 thing in this video that you learned for the first time, or that you found interesting.
2. Dr. Deutsch claims that teenagers are more likely to suffer health consequences from getting Coronavirus, then to suffer a side-effect from Coronavirus vaccines. Do you agree? Is this a good argument for teenagers to get vaccinated?
3. Dr. Deutsch states that there will be “emotional consequences” if you catch Coronavirus at school and one of your family members gets sick and dies. Is this a fair statement? Do younger people have a responsibility to get vaccinated to protect older people?
4. Dr. Deutsch argues that “collective action” is the only way to get rid of Coronavirus. Can you think of any examples of where everyone taking action together was necessary to bring about an important change?
5. Dr. Deutsch speaks about vaccines in the context of health equity, stating that “some people's lives are still considered less valuable than the cost of a vaccine.” He notes that less than 2% of the continent of Africa has been vaccinated against Coronavirus and argues that everyone in the world should be vaccinated free of charge. Do you agree or disagree? Do people have a right to be vaccinated against infectious diseases regardless of their ability to pay for the vaccines?
6. Do you think that mass vaccination against Smallpox, Measles and Polio has been good for the world? Do you think that life would be better if everyone got vaccinated against Coronavirus?
